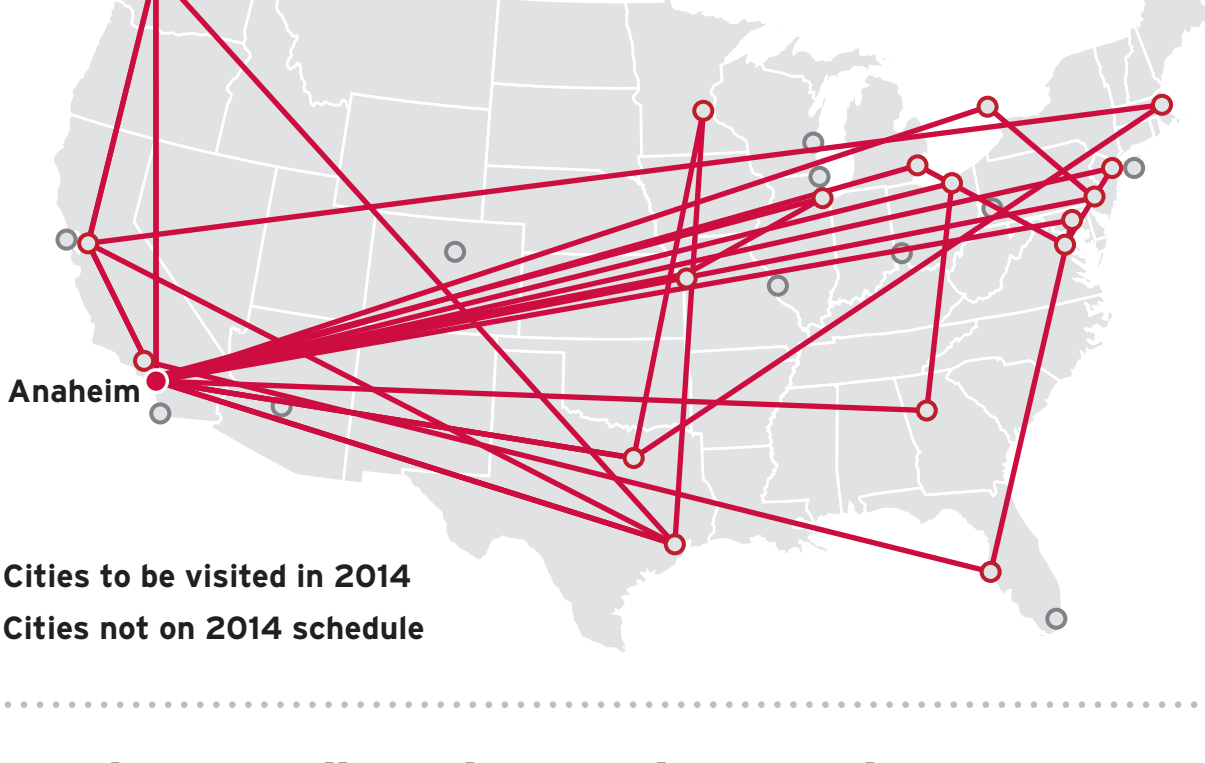


Around the World in 2014 – Twice

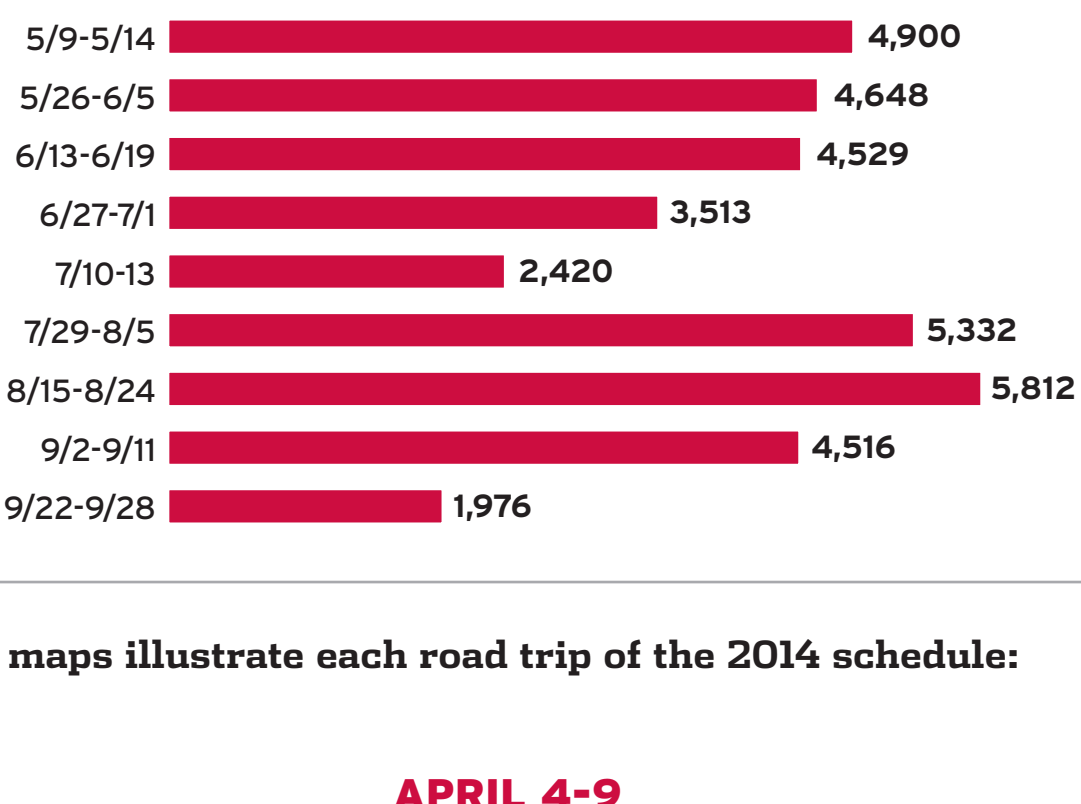
The Angels will travel some **46,897 miles*** during the 2014 regular season, nearly twice the circumference of the Earth's 24,901 miles. The team will take **11 road trips**, making **26 stops in 18 cities**, including five in the National League: Washington (Nationals), New York (Mets), Philadelphia (Phillies), Atlanta (Braves) and Los Angeles (Dodgers). The average round trip is 4,263 miles — the longest being 5,812 during a jaunt that includes Texas, Boston and Oakland.
