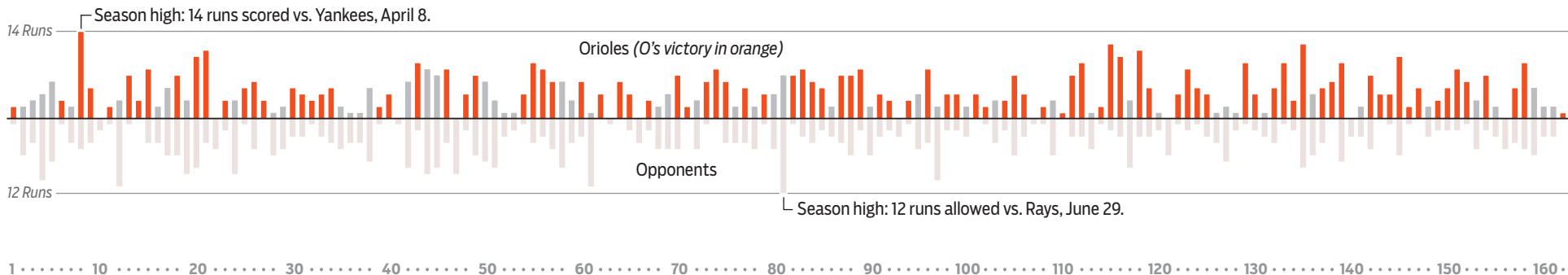


Runs scored vs. runs against

The Orioles outscored opponents 705 to 593 over the course of the 162-game season, an average difference of .69 runs per game and a median of 4.35 runs scored vs. 3.66 runs allowed per game.



Games above .500

The Orioles struggled to maintain a winning record through the first half of the season with a 42-39 record after the first 81 games. Despite key injuries and the suspension of Chris Davis, the O's pulled away from their division rivals, winning 54 of their last 81 games and finishing 30 games above the .500 mark.
